The Thai Red Cross Society Princess Sirindhorn Eye Surgery Unit



The most common and serious eye problems found in elderly are cataract, pterygium and glaucoma, which should be examined and properly treated by an ophthalmologist, because, if not remedied, blindness may result.



In 1995, in honour of HRH Princess Sirindhorn, Executive Vice President, the Thai Red Cross Society revived its eye surgery unit to examine and correct eye problems of the vulnerable and less fortunate. HRH graciously bestowed the unit the name Princess Sirindhorn Eye Surgery Unit under Her Patronage with priority on treating less fortunate elderly citizens in poor outlying rural areas. The unit initially worked with The Thai Red Cross Health station VI in Aranyaprathet District, Sa kaeo Province. At the present time, the unit also work with community hospitals seven times all around the country per year providing free services. Up to now more than 133,602 patients have been treated and over 35,555 operated on (August 2012). After the patient was done eye operation, they had better quality of life due to improving their eye sight.

The Thai Red Cross Society expresses its deep appreciation to all those who donate to support the work of the Princess Sirindhorn Eye Surgery Unit.

Operational goals

The Unit has set the target of examining 8,000 patients with eye problems per year and performing 1,000 corrective eye surgery operations per year. The cost of surgery per person around 5,000 baht.
