

Thai Red Cross Project to Provide Eyeglasses for School Children in Rural Areas



Problem with eyesight affects everyday life especially for children, causing difficulties in studying and therefore lifelong problems. Wearing eyeglasses may provide a solution.







Relief and Community Health Bureau of the Thai Red Cross Society realizes the gravity of this problem. In 1997, the Bureau initiated the Eyeglasses for School Children Project, sending mobile medical units to remote rural areas to measure children's eyesight and providing corrective eyeglasses to those who need them, free of charge. The Project also raises awareness amongst parents, teachers and the children themselves to prevent eyesight abnormalities.

As of October 2012, of 5,590,728 children in 77 provinces whose eyesight have been examined, 53,635 have been issued corrective eyeglasses.



Operational goals

The Project's target is to measure the eyesight of 400,000 children per year and to provide eyeglasses to 3,000 children with a cost of 600 baht a pair.
